

2022 Ice Hut Rental Policy

COVID PROTOCOLS

- All renters must be fully vaccinated with two doses of an approved COVID 19 Vaccine.
- All renters must complete the COVID-19 screening form prior to rental. Refusal of the form, or not passing the screening will result in a cancellation or rescheduling of the rental for the safety of all those involved.
- Wikwemikong Tourism Ice Hut rentals are limited to ***5 persons per rental.***
- DO NOT, at ANY time, congregate in groups or meet others at the ice hut. Enjoy the attraction/service with **ONLY** the members of your family from the same household or members of your social circle.
- Always practice the usual personal protective measures such as washing your hands, and respect physical distancing, and when that isn't possible, please wear a facial mask or facial covering.
- Huts and equipment will be sanitized by Wikwemikong Tourism following the rental.

RENTAL POLICY

- Wikwemikong Tourism will provide a portable heater and ice scoop as part of the rental. Holes will be drilled inside and outside the hut.
- Please be sure to abide by applicable fishing zone regulations as set out by the Ontario Fishing Regulations; know your limits and live bait restrictions - <https://www.ontario.ca/document/ontario-fishing-regulations-summary/fisheries-management-zones-map>
- A key will be provided to unlock the hut for your rental. Please lock the hut before leaving the area
- Please ensure the hut is left as you found it. Remember to leave no trace. Don't litter. Please take your trash home with you.
- Transportation to the ice hut is available for a fee.
- Pack your necessary hygiene supplies (toilet paper and hand sanitizer) including food and beverages.
- Read posted signage & respect the safety measures of the area (i.e. Trespassing, staked net locations).
