## Multi-day itinerary – Manitoulin Island-Killarney Motor Coach Tours

### Day One Itinerary:

Depart hotel to Wiikwemkoong Unceded Territory

Arrive 1836 historic site: Met by Wikwemikong Tourism step-on guides

*The Unceded Journey guided tour:* learn the history of Odawa Mnis (Manitoulin Island) and Wiikwemkoong Unceded Territory—Canada’s only officially recognized Unceded Indian Reserve. Includes stops at four historic sites including 1836 Treaty historic site, Holy Cross Mission Ruins (residential school site), Smith Bay trading site.

*Catered lunch:* Authentic Indigenous Cuisine
