Arrive 1836 historic site: Met by Wikwemikong Tourism step-on guides

The Unceded Journey guided tour: learn the history of Odawa Mnis (Manitoulin Island) and Wiikwemkoong Unceded Territory—Canada’s only officially recognized Unceded Territory. Includes stops at historic sites including 1836 Treaty historic site, Holy Cross Mission Ruins (residential school site)

Bebamikawe “Making Footprints”: An interpretive hike through the ecologically diverse Bebamikawe Memorial Trail while learning about plants harvested for edibility and medicinal purposes
