Amik Ziibii Cultural Experience: Your Anishnaabe guide will share centuries old knowledge of plants, their edibility, and healing properties. You will connect with nature by learning about the traditional uses and sciences behind the teachings. Enjoy stunning vistas, hear the history of Point Grondine, and authentic Anishnaabe culinary cuisine to take home a new found appreciation for Anishinaabe Culture.

Hike the Crack in Killarney: Beginning at Killarney Mountain Lodge, the Lighthouse Hike takes you through a

mixed forest of pine, red maple, and the occasional spruce, over pink granite rocks and along the rugged Georgian Bay coastline. The East Lighthouse provides a stunning view, looking out over the bay, Manitoulin Island, and the boat traffic moving in and out of the Killarney Channel, making it one of the most iconic parts of Killarney.

Killarney Lighthouse Tour: Easily one of the most popular and rewarding hikes in Ontario. The trail starts flat in forest but at about the halfway point the climb begins. It turns to smooth white quartzite then some giant boulders. A scenic and historical adventure located on the northern shore of Georgian Bay in Ontario, Canada, near Killarney Provincial Park. The lighthouse itself, known as the Killarney East Lighthouse or Red Rock Lighthouse, has been a navigational landmark since the late 19th century. The Killarney Lighthouse Tour is an unforgettable experience, blending natural beauty, history, and a bit of adventure. It's a great way to connect with the area's maritime history and enjoy Ontario's wilderness.

Unceded Journey: Through our Unceded Journey Tour, experience the history of Odawa Mnis (Manitoulin Island) and Wiikwemkoong – Canada's only officially recognized Unceded Territory. Our guide will take you to four historic

sites to view plaques and monuments and recount the history of Manitoulin Island. This educational experience will share the 1836 and 1862 treaties of Manitoulin Island, intrigue you with the local lore and legend of Zhibzhii the underwater spirit, and take you back in time to the now infamous "Manitoulin Incident".
